Steve completed his coaching qualifications whilst working as a PE teacher and is a level 3 qualified coach with plans to undertake the level 4 qualification in the next two years.

In 2015, Steve competed in the Irish masters qualifying tournament where he accrued enough points to be selected at number 3 for the Irish Over 45 team.
